

INFORMATION FOR CAMPERS

Disposal of Waste

The following items must be separated out.

Drinks cans “NOT FOOD CANS” must be taken to the recycling area in the church yard.

Glass bottles and jars must be placed directly into the blue bins in the Churchyard. Jars must be washed out before disposal

Plastic bottles “NOT FOOD TRAYS” must be placed in a coloured bag or taken to the bins in the churchyard.

Clean card board must be put into coloured bags and put in the church yard.

Other waste should be put into the wheelie bins near the tuck shop.

We are not responsible for disposing of large items brought onto the site for your use. Eg tents broken chairs tables etc. If they are left there will be a charge of £5.00 per item.

Under no circumstances are tyres to be left on the site. The environmental agency will be informed and it will be treated as fly tipping.

Fires (not referring to the camp fire circle)

All fires produce carbon dioxide, so only burn a fire when necessary. There is no need to burn a fire in the daytime unless they are used for cooking. If in the evening you want a fire to sit around it should be a focus for the group not a fire to keep warm.

Do not have fires directly on the ground unless it is on a concrete base and always use an altar fire if one is available even on a concrete base.

When using altar fires, the wood should only be placed below the metal grid. Damage will occur to the altar fire if wood is placed above the grid. Only one altar fire to be used at once, not 2 side by side. All unused fire wood should be returned to the wood pile, not deliberately burned to dispose of it. Next week some one else will need wood.

Vehicles

All vehicles must be parked in the assigned parking areas and parked close to the barriers and close to one another. There may only be one other car when you arrive but other people have to park later .

Vehicles should not be parked outside the entrance gates. Vehicles are only allowed onto the camping areas at the discretion of the warden. Generally only vehicles containing large amounts of equipment will be allowed on the camping area and only for a period whilst they are being unloaded.

Vehicles left on the camping area overnight without specific permission from the warden (and without good reason) will be charged £ 5.00 per vehicle per night.

Remember if your cooperation is not forthcoming, during the camp, when it is time to reload, you may wish you had obeyed the rules when you unloaded.

After heavy rain only vehicles towing a trailer will be allowed on the camping area but only on the hard standing areas.

Care of our equipment

Chairs and tables are primarily for use in the buildings. If the weather is fine tables may be used outside adjacent to the buildings but not on camping areas. Chairs may be used outside, but if they become dirty they must be cleaned.

Drawing pins, staples and tape must not be used on plastered walls, they damage the plaster.

Tree preservation order

The majority of trees on the site are covered by a tree preservation order with a fine of up to £20,000 if they are damaged. The culprit is the law breaker not the tree owner.

Inspection of camp site

Before you leave can you please notify the warden that the site and or buildings are clean and tidy and are ready for inspection.

Dogs on site

No dogs are allowed on the campsite. This is for hygiene and safety reasons Please ensure any visitors are aware of this rule. The only exception to this is a warden's dog or a guide dog. Unfortunately we cannot prevent the general public from bringing dogs on the public foot path, but they must be under control.
