 PROBABILITY; 1-IMPROBABLE, ONLY A RISK UNDER FREAK CONDITIONS 2-REMOTE, RISK ONLY WITH OTHER FACTORS PRESENT
 3-POSSIBLE, RISK IF OTHER FACTORS PRECIPITATE IT eg. OBSTRUCT FIRE EXIT 4-PROBABLE, RISK IF EFFECTS OF HUMANS OR OTHER FACTOR CAUSE ACCIDENT eg. OIL SPILL
 5-LIKELY, CERTAIN ACCIDENT eg. DEFECTIVE BRAKES
 RISK RATING; LOW = 1-10 MEDIUM = 11-15 HIGH = 16-25
